

Erratum**Four new and six rediscovered water beetles for Belgium (Coleoptera: Elmidae, Helophoridae, Heteroceridae, Hydraenidae, Scirtidae)**

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All water beetles in this article were checked by pictures and mostly male genitalia were very clear to confirm identification by pictures, but from *Ochthebius pusillus* Stephens, 1835 only females were found. The first author did send pictures to two specialists who both supposed this was indeed *O. pusillus*. Manfred Jäch is a world expert on Hydraenidae from Austria and checked these specimens. He concluded they should be identified as *O. marinus* (Paykull, 1798) and noticed an optical illusion in the pictures, which confused the other specialists.

It is surprising this halobiont species is found so far inland. The closest known populations are situated in Saefthinge at about 50 km from Holsbeek and 150 km from Burg-Reuland.
