NOTES ON SOME CIRRIPEDS FROM THE VOYAGE
OF H. R. H. THE PRINCE LEOPOLD OF BELGIUM
TO THE FAR EAST IN THE YEAR 1932.

A little collection of cirripeds which I have received from the Natural History Museum, Brussels, was brought home by H. R. H. the Prince Leopold of Belgium from a second journey to the Far East in the year 1932. All the three species are well known before. As a supplement to the earlier expedition to the Malay Archipelago in the year 1929 (NILSSON-CANTELL, 1932) the exactly given localities may here be given.

Pollicipes mitella (Linnaeus, 1767)
For synonymy see N.-C., 1921.

Two fullgrown specimens. The capitular valves wore as earlier stated (NILSSON-CANTELL, 1921) from Japanese specimens some smaller barnacles *Chthamalus challengerii*.

NEW LOCALITY: Mamberao. North-western coast of Mindoro.
3. IV. 1932.

DISTRIBUTION: Indo-Pacific. This species already (1851) mentioned by Darwin from the Philippine Archipelago is well represented in the collections of many museums, but because not all finds are published it will be of value to get an exact locality.

Lepas anserifera Linnaeus, 1767

Some specimens of different sizes on a little piece of wood.

NEW LOCALITY: Tjandikoesoma. Western coast of Bali. 25-26
IV. 1932.

DISTRIBUTION: Pelagic in tropical and temperate seas.

Chthamalus challengerii Hoek, 1883
For synonymy see N.-C. 1921.

Some specimens on the capitular valves of *Pollicipes mitella*.
The specimens agree with those described by the author (1921)
from Japan and Java.

NEW LOCALITY: Mamberao. North-western coast of Mindoro.
3. IV. 1932.

DISTRIBUTION: Japan, Malay Archipelago. According to Broch
(1927) also from Red Sea. On stone and valves of *Pollicipes mi-
tella*.
